OUR FIVE PROGRAMS



Children First offers child abuse prevention classes to children (Speak Up Be Safe™) in schools and training for adults who work with children (Stewards of Children™).



Healthy Families is a national home-based, evidence-based family support and coaching program that supports parents and helps them create stable, nurturing environments for their children.

The program matches parents with trained professionals who visit families' homes to provide support during pregnancy and the child's first 3 years of life. Home visitors teach parents about proper baby care, promote nurturing and attachment, practice effective parenting skills, and ensure parents have a solid understanding of healthy child development. They also counsel parents on achieving personal goals such as going back to school or securing a job.



The Trauma Informed Community Network seeks to educate the Roanoke Valley about trauma, trauma-informed care, and resiliency. TICN connects organizations in all sectors with resources, training, and techniques for implementing trauma-informed systems to help everyone thrive. Children's Trust anchors TICN and is the backbone agency, now including 20+ organizations.





Children's Advocacy Centers (CAC) are child-friendly facilities designed to reduce the trauma children endure during the investigation and prosecution of abuse. The CAC operates regional centers in Roanoke, Bedford, the New River Valley.

The CAC works with multi-disciplinary team that includes medical professionals, law enforcement, mental health, the Commonwealth Attorney's office, child protective services, victim advocacy, and other professionals who make decisions together about how to help the child based on the interview.



The **Court Appointed Special Advocates for Children** (CASA) program trains and supervises volunteers who advocate for the best interests of abused and neglected children in foster care, ensuring they have safe, permanent homes.

Volunteers get to know the child by talking with everyone in the child's life; parents and relatives, foster parents, teachers, medical professionals, attorneys, social workers, and others. They use the information they gather to inform judges and others of what the child needs and what will be the best permanent home for them.
